**FROM THE PASTOR**  
 Wednesday is the Solemnity of All Saints, which is a Holy Day of Obligation. Please see the daily schedule for mass times.

Thursday is the Solemnity of All Souls. It is not a Holy Day of Obligation, but it is the one day during the year, that, universally, priests are allowed to say three masses. Weather permitting, the Angelus mass and the afternoon Oakley mass will be in the cemetery. Please see the daily schedule for mass times.

As we celebrate the Solemnities of All Saints and All Souls this week, I can't help but be reminded of the great hope, joy, and power of intercessory prayer these celebrations bring. All Saints reminds us that we are all called to holiness and the look forward in hope the kingdom of heaven, the beatific vision. We are not called to imitate the Saints, but to imitate Christ himself, whom the Saints looked to for ultimate strength in their lives. The various types of Saints remind us that while we are all called to the universal call of holiness, each individual path looks different, but end goal is the same. How beautiful, marvelous, and inspiring that is for us still on this earth! All Souls reminds us that, as members of the Body of Christ we need to pray for our departed brothers and sisters in the hope that they will see heaven. Unless one is declared, at minimum, a Servant of God (the first step in the process towards Sainthood) we should offer intercessory prayers for them to hopefully be released from purgatory into heaven. Once one is declared a Servant of God, a Venerable, a Blessed or a Saint, masses said for the salvation of their soul is no longer necessary, because the Church has discerned them to be in heaven. Everyone else, we pray for their salvation, even if it is highly unlikely, we still hope for the best for their soul. To be separated from God's love for all eternity is the worst result for a soul. Let us take the time to contemplate these mysteries this week, and allow ourselves to pray not only for our own salvation, but for the salvation of every soul, and ask the Angels and Saints to intercede for us and them.
